GREENBRIER FENCE GUIDELINES

- 1. All fence requests must be approved in advance by the Greenbrier Property Owners Association (GPOA) Board of Directors, following recommendation by the Architectural and Covenants Committee.
- 2. Requests must be in writing using the Application for Architectural Change Request form found at the <Greenbriernc.org> web site, to include approval signatures or dissenting comments of adjacent neighbors.
- 3. Fence material may generally be wood, wrought steel, aluminum, or vinyl. Other material may be considered on a case by case basis. Chain link, chicken wire or electrified fences are not allowed.
- 4. Items such as decorations, murals, attached sculpture and illuminated devices are not permitted.
- 5. Fences may be no higher than five (5) feet.
- 6. The color should be natural, painted or stained to complement the dwelling.
- 7. Fences will be located directly behind the building with sides enclosed by extension of the side walls of the building.
- 8. Fences may in no case encroach upon drainage or utility easements or minimum building setback lines as shown on the plat.
- 9. Variances may be considered for irregularly shaped lots and if topography or other considerations warrant.
- 10. Fences are not allowed on lots adjacent to the golf course.
